Visitors to Bidjigal Reserve take note:

- The reserve is a sanctuary for native plants and animals; please do not damage, disturb or injure them.
- Creek water is unsafe for drinking or swimming.
- Quickly leave the creek areas if it rains, as water levels can rise rapidly in heavy or consistent rain.
- Dogs can be taken into the reserve, but must be on a leash at all times.
- The reserve is periodically closed to dogs. This is for fox baiting and warning signs will be posted at all access points.
- Fires should only be lit in designated fireplaces.
- The network has frequent steep, rugged and uneven sections and informal creek crossings, sometimes with slippery rocks, which may not be passable during wet weather.
